Dear St. James Church and Preschool Families:

In an ongoing effort to do anything we can to create the safest environment possible, the church has been involved in an extensive, months-long exercise exploring air purification options for our campus. After working with multiple vendors and researching several options, we are excited to report that in December, the St. James Church Council approved moving forward with an HVAC System Upgrade for air purification. While this system will not eliminate or replace existing safety measures, it will augment them. Some key benefits of this new system are:

- 90%+ air purification
- Significant reduction in airborne viruses and bacteria
- Reduced dust, mold, and allergens
- Less odors

This system is not a cure for COVID-19, but it is a highly effective and proven air purification technology that has been around for decades. We are confident this improvement will offer long-term health benefits long after the COVID crisis is behind us. The church is placing the order for the purification system on faith in hopes that our church and preschool families will rally around the cause with one-time special funding financial contributions/pledges.

We are asking for, and need your financial support. We understand 2020 has been a difficult year. Any amount you can give/pledge would be greatly appreciated.





Weekly Gatherings on Zoom— The Student Ministries at St. James UMC are in full gear! We have been continuing with Confirmation, Sunday School, and Sunday Night Youth Group. All of our programming has been on Zoom, but we are still managing to build and grow in community with one another! We have 19 Confirmands who are diligently growing in their faith and understanding of God and the Church. Right now, we are scheduling Confirmation Sunday to be on Sunday, May 23rd - Pentecost.
